2019 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ FUNDED 38 PROJECTS, an investment of over \$356,000, through the Incubation and Action Grant Program
- ▶ PROVIDED OVER 200 SUBSIDIZED PUBLIC EVENTS through the Public Scholars Project
- ▶ HOSTED THE SMITHSONIAN INSTITUTION'S MUSEUM ON MAIN STREET "WATER/WAYS" EXHIBIT at different locations throughout the state, offering a way for NJ residents to examine the environmental, cultural, and historical views of one of our most essential resources
- ▶ BROUGHT THE INTERACTIVE COMMUNITY CONVERSATION "WHAT IS YOUR WATER STORY?" TO ALL 21 COUNTIES, resulting in a significant contribution to a growing public archive about water
