Why a "lab"?

- Experimentation is as foundational to the humanities as it is to science.
- Learn new things.
- Meet others who care about the same stuff we do.

What are the program components?

Learning + Funding + Community

Components: Learning

- Cohort sessions
- Individual meetings
- Assignments
- Final product: new project plan and budget

Components: Funding

- \$500 participation stipend
- Additional funding up to \$5000 to pilot new projects – decided by participants!

Components: Community

- Cohort of participants
- Guest speakers
- Optional meet-ups after the program

Who should apply?

- NJ-based organizations who do (or want to do) public humanities work
- Current grantees/program partners, check in first
- Special considerations

- Interviews: now through May 10 → Required!
- Cohort sessions: weeks of June 17 (in person), July 8 (virtual), July 22 (virtual), August 5 (in person)
- Final cohort meeting and celebration: late September or early October (in person)
